We need to add cross reference to the academic freedom BP/AP and I cannot find them in Board Docs. Can you please address, Anu? c. Workgroup suggested adding reference to training “consistent with legal requirements” which is now there with an explanatory comment. d. FA’s feedback was to ensure this is consistent with contract terms, which it likely is, and additionally, this BP effectuates federal legal requirements, which should not be subject to bargaining. 2. AP 3433 – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Changes discussed in workgroup were made, including clarifying “on the basis of sex” and reformatting bullets to properly separate stalking from sexual assault. 3. AP 3434 – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Definitions of Title IX Sexual Harassment now match version discussed (and draft) in AP 3433, and are the most up-to-date Title IX definitions b. Cleaned up the Officials With Authority (Mandated Reporter/Responsible Employee) section consistent with discussion, and 	Anu Khanna/ Dianna Rose/Christopher Dela Rosa

	<p>resequenced some sentences to ease readability. The workgroup had a good discussion of the nomenclature of “responsible employee” v “mandated reporter” – given that Title IX specifically does not use either of these terms, I recommend that once the Director gets in place, a determination is made with further discussion with stakeholders about what is the right term of art to use here, primarily reinforcing responsibilities while avoiding any confusion with any mandated reporting obligations under state law to child/adult protective services.</p> <p>c. The FA attorney suggested that the topics of training under this AP are negotiable; however, for individuals who play “roles” here in a Title IX process, the training topics are prescribed by federal Title IX regulations (34 CFR Part 106).</p> <p>4. BP 3540 – there were not substantive changes to this from the workgroup. We should confirm/clean up the cross references before/after CAC consideration.</p> <p>5. AP3540 –</p> <p>a. mostly clean-up here following the workgroup discussion. I ended up using the formulation “District or Title IX Coordinator” to reflect that given current staffing, any of the three Title IX Coordinators could end up providing this info depending on the circumstances, and I saw this phrasing used appropriately among other CA multi-college districts.</p> <p>b. I removed the language associated with victim/abuse counselors as FHDA does not have these individuals on staff; however, the information that will be provided to victims will refer them to these resources in your local community.</p>
