## 3. Finalize Siting Criteria Recommendation

- In the preamble, recommend that the district pursue feasibility of on-campus housing as part of the search for a site
- Clarify that a full-service supermarket should accept EBT
- Add that child care should be affordable
- Include the full membership of the task force at the end of the letter

The members unanimously approved the recommendation letter with these changes. Eric will email the recommendation to the Chancellor and Board of Trustees, and present at the next Chancellor's Advisory Council meeting on February 11<sup>th</sup>.
